### A FEW LISTS TO CONTEMPLATE

Today in my quiet time I came across this:

The **law** of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul; The **testimony** of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple The **precepts** of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; The **commandment** of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes; The **fear** of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; The **rules** of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb. Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great Psalm 19:7-11 reward.

While I was reading this, I couldn't help but notice that this list of attributes of the Lord's Word is similar to Philippians 4:8:

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.

Then I noticed the various words used to describe/define God's Word...

Hands – Giving
Eyes – God's Vision – His plan for you to follow
Ears – Hearing God's Word
Lips – Sharing your testimony. . . not always the entire thing, but what relates to the situation.
Windows – Pouring out your heart to God regarding all things.
Heart – Goes with ears – Hearing God's Word and hiding it your heart so we live by it.
Doors – Asking God where He would have you serve others. (Not just in Church, but in life.)

I know I've given you a few things that may or may not be of interest to you, but I found them interesting enough to pass along. If you choose, you can always cut them out and put them in your Bible for quick reference. Keep in mind that <u>the Bible is God's love letter to you.</u> Read it often. Hide His Word in your heart.
